The above described yearling was examined at Vinery Stud on the 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2019.

There was a moderate laceration down the dorsal aspect of the right fore cannon. The wound was flushed clean, debrided and surgically stapled closed. There was no evidence of any significant involvement of deeper tissues.

The leg was bandaged and the yearling departed Vinery Stud on the 24<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

The expectation would be that there is a resulting scar but that there would be no underlying issues resultant from the injury.



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
