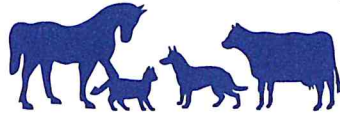

The horse was found to have a cracked quarter on the right hind hoof, this is a result of a trauma to the hoof and coronary band as a foal. This has had no effect on her movement and she has no sign of lameness.

There is no impediment for this horse to enter race training.
